

## Student Parking Expectations of Our Student Drivers

Dear Student and Parent/Guardian:

Earl Marriott Secondary supports students driving to school, where families have deemed this is to occur. To accommodate this mode of transportation, the school has assigned 60 stalls for student parking which are the first three rows north of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue. These stalls are available on a first-come first-served basis each day. Thus, if student parking is filled upon arrival to school, another location off school property will have to be sought out.

Student parking is only available to a limited number of grade 12 students. In order to park a vehicle(s) in the parking lot, a student parking pass is required, which can be picked up at the Office for \$10.00 - one pass per student. In order to receive a parking pass, this Expectation Letter and the attached Student Checklist must be scanned and returned to Mrs. Beveridge at beveridge\_t@surreyschools.ca.

As a member of the EMS driving community, it is our expectation that the student driver will adhere to the rules of the road while on school property (as well as when in the community). Furthermore, we ask that students **park only in the two rows designated as student parking**. Please do not park in "Staff Parking", "Visitors Parking", near or around the portables, or in the fire lane behind the school/Main Gym, and refrain from double parking anywhere on school property. **Should any of the above occur, the driver risks having the vehicle towed, and ultimately, losing the privilege to park on school property.**
